The VHF/Digital Selective Calling is a great seminar that demonstrates what DSC is all about, which DSC radios are already obsolete and demonstrates the merits of DCS for other than emergencies. Sail Trim explains the dynamics of wind on the sails and how to get the most out of trimming the sails.

Directions: 42 Great Neck Road, Waterford, CT

I-95 North to exit 75 straight onto Post Road/Route 1 North. Follow Route 1 for 3.7 miles. Passing the U.S. Post Office and Silva's Package Store on the right, turn right at traffic light onto Avery Lane, go straight across the next intersection, where Avery Lane becomes Great Neck Road. Defender Industries headquarters and Warehouse Outlet Store are 1/2 mile on the left.

I-95 South to exit 81. Turn left at light onto Parkway North. At 2nd traffic light, turn left onto Cross Road. Follow Cross Road to 2nd traffic light, turn left on Post Road/Route 1. Follow Route 1 for 1.6 miles. Passing the U.S. Post Office and Silva's Package Store on the right. Take right then follow directions for I-95N.
